Recent Board Action

At its Regular Village Board Meeting of April 14, 2008, the Village Board of Trustees:

- Approved an Ordinance amending Title 12-5 of the Personnel Policies Manual which covers changes in the Family Medical Leave Act.
- Approved a Change Order to add a sidewalk to the Construction Contract for the construction of a traffic signal at Olde Half Day Road and Milwaukee Avenue. The sidewalk will go from the Vernon Area Public Library to Milwaukee Avenue.

- Approved an Ordinance Authorizing the Sale of Surplus Equipment in the Northwest Municipal Conference Auction to be held in May.

Summer Water Restrictions

Outside water usage will be restricted in the Village between May 15th through September 15th.



If your address ends in an even number (0, 2, 4, 6, 8), then you may use outside water on calendar days which are even. Similarly, if your address ends in an odd number (1, 3, 5, 7, 9), you may use outside water on calendar days which are odd.

Despite the vast pool of water to our east known as Lake Michigan, there is not an unlimited supply of water in this area. Under an international treaty, communities bordering Lake Michigan are restricted in the amount of water that can be withdrawn from the lake. As a result, the Illinois Department of Natural Resources, Office of Water Resources,



requires communities to take measures to conserve water. Outside water use restrictions are implemented by communities as one such conservation. In Lincolnshire, residents may use potable water outside-of-buildings, including water used for sprinkling of lawns and gardens or washing cars, in accordance with this odd/even schedule.

You should bring a passport-size photo, and you will be required to fill out an application. If you do not have a small photo, your photo can be taken at the Township, but the cost is \$8.00 each. It takes about four weeks to receive your pass.

Spring Lake Beach Opens

Spring Lake Beach will be open for swimming the weekends of Saturday, May 24th, and May 31st. The regular season will begin on June 2nd daily until August 19th. The beach will again be open the weekends of August 23rd, and September 3rd. Lifeguards are on duty daily from 10:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. Swimming is allowed from sunrise to sunset, from the Saturday before Memorial Day to the 30th of September. However, when no lifeguards are on duty, and you want to swim, it will be at your own risk. When lifeguards are off duty, swimmers age 16 and under must be accompanied by an adult. When there is a rain event, it is recommended that you wait to swim in the lake for 24 to 48 hours because of the possibility of bacteria in the water. Chicago River Day

Annual Street Resurfacing Project

The 2008 edition of the Annual Street Resurfacing Project began in late April. The Village will be resurfacing Bristol Court, Anglican Lane, Portshire Drive, Grenadier Court, Cornell Drive, Reliance Lane (from Kings Cross to Cornell Drive), and Pembroke Drive. Residents along these streets will receive construction updates to help keep them informed of the project's progress.

Residential Tire and Oil Collection

Excellence in Residential Landscaping Awards - 2008

The Village of Lincolnshire is very fortunate that so many of its residents take pride in creating and maintaining private property landscapes of the highest quality.

2008 marks the 4th anniversary of the Village of Lincolnshire Excellence in Landscaping Awards. This year the Village will be recognizing excellence in residential landscape design and maintenance by presenting two (2) awards. One award will be for the property voted "Best Front Yard Landscape," and the other award will recognize the property voted to have the "Best Rear Yard Landscape". All properties nominated in each of the categories will be judged based on design, upkeep, and overall visual appeal.

If you would like to nominate a neighbor's, front and/or rear yard landscape for the 2008 Excellence in Landscaping Award, simply follow these steps:

1. Take pictures of the landscape (try to capture the beauty of the landscape when it is at its best throughout the growing season).
2. Record the street address, and name of the property owner.

4. Nominations must be received by September 1st, 2008.

The nominated landscapes will all be judged during the month of September, and the award recipients will be recognized at an October Village Board meeting.

Voter Registration

Voter registration is open in Lake County except the 27 days preceding an election. It reopens the second day following an election. You may register if you are a United States citizen; 18 years of age by the date of the next election; and a resident of your Lake County precinct address for 30 days prior to an election. You need to have two forms of identification and one of the two forms must show your name and current address. The second form can be a piece of mail from a contractual service addressed and delivered to you. You can register to vote at the Lincolnshire Village Hall, Vernon Township or the County Clerk's office in Waukegan. If you moved since the last election, you need to re-register.

Wastehauler Pickup

Because of the Memorial Day holiday, Waste Management North will pick up the single-family residential homes' garbage and recyclables on Thursday, May 29th, rather than Wednesday, May 28th.



Candidate Signage

The Village Code regulates the size of political signs. The maximum size for political signs is six square feet, which is the size of a standard 2 x 3 foot sign, and it cannot be any higher than four feet off the ground.

All political signs must be displayed no more than thirty-six days prior to and removed within two days after an election. Since the next election is on Tuesday, November 4th this year, no political signs should go up before Monday, September 29th, and they should be taken down by Thursday, November 6th. Since the wastehaulers come through the Village on Wednesdays, it's a good idea to take the sign out of your yard and put it at the curb at the same time you put your waste and recycleables there.

Signs must be placed on private property with the consent of the homeowner. Private property typically begins fifteen feet from the roadway. Rights-of-way along roads such as Riverwoods Road, Route 22, and Milwaukee Avenue are not private property. Any signage along these roadways must be placed on private property with the consent of the homeowners. Any signage not meeting this criteria will be removed by the Village staff.



Parking Recreational Vehicles

The Village has specific regulations about parking recreational vehicles in residential areas. The Village Code considers a recreational vehicle to include, but not be limited to, any boat, trailer, snowmobile, camper, house trailer and motor home. The parking of these vehicles within the Village is prohibited on a full-time basis but temporary parking, not to exceed seven (7) days, can be granted by the Chief of Police for loading or unloading or maintenance of these vehicles.



If you would like to have your recreational vehicle parked at your residence on a more permanent basis, the Village does allow each resident to keep one recreational vehicle on their property as long as they adhere to the following conditions:

1. The vehicle must be parked in a side yard or rear yard of a 1 lot, provided that no part of the recreational vehicle projects beyond the front of the residence or garage.
2. The vehicle needs to be parked no less than 10 feet (10') from any side yard or rear yard lot line.
3. The vehicle needs to be parked in such a manner that it is fully screened from adjacent properties. (Full screening in this case refers to any vegetation or foliage which maintains its foliage all year round and is large enough to totally screen the vehicle.)

New Laws that Affect Drivers Under the Age of 18!

2008 brought some changes to the law that affect children under the age of 18. Outlined below are the most common laws that will apply to your child.

Curfew - There is a state-wide curfew for everyone under the age of 17. It is unlawful for those under the age of 17 to be out between the hours of 11 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday – Thursday; and 12 a.m. to 6 a.m., Friday – Saturday.

The Village of Lincolnshire's curfew ordinance mirrors state law. Other municipalities may have a stricter ordinance in place. It's important to check with other municipalities before assuming their ordinance is the same.

It's important to remember if your child is found to be in violation of the above curfew hours they are subject to arrest.

Nighttime Driving Restriction - This is a new law in Illinois. This restriction limits how late drivers under the age of 18 are allowed to be operating a vehicle. The nighttime driving restriction has nothing to do with the curfew law. All Drivers under the age of 18 may not drive a vehicle between the hours of 10 p.m. and 6 a.m. Sunday - Thursday. All Drivers under the age of 18 may not drive

Number of Passengers - For the first year of licensing, or until the driver is age 18, whichever occurs first, the number of passengers is limited to one person under age 20, unless the additional passenger(s) is a sibling, step-sibling, child, or step-child of the driver. After this period, the number of passengers is limited to one in the front seat and the number of safety belts in the back seat.

Seat Belt Use - Everyone under the age of 19 is required to wear their seatbelt regardless of where they are sitting in the vehicle.

Under 18 Cell Phone Use - Cell phone use while driving is prohibited, except in the case of an emergency to contact a law enforcement agency, health care provider or emergency services agency.

- **Waste Management North is the single waste hauler for most residents in Lincolnshire.** If you have questions or problems, the waste hauler can be reached at 800-796-9696 or 630-724-8400. However, if you are a member of a Homeowners' Association, your home is not necessarily covered by Waste Management North. Check with your Homeowners' Association for more information.

- **If you have any old major appliances you wish to discard, call Environmental Field Service at 800-480-4337.** This service will collect these appliances for a fee that is much lower than what Waste Management North would charge.
